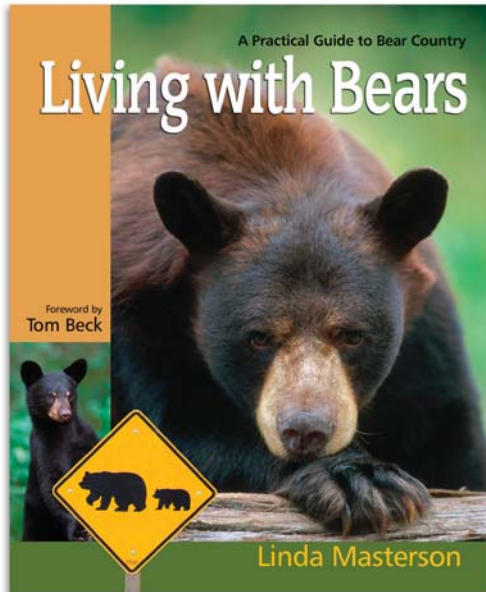


Do your bears have people problems?

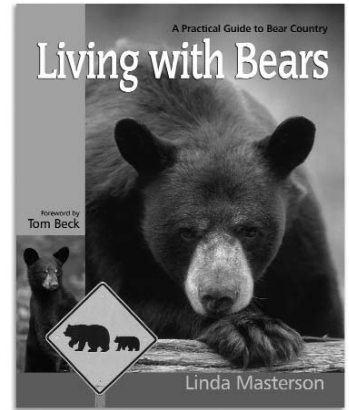
